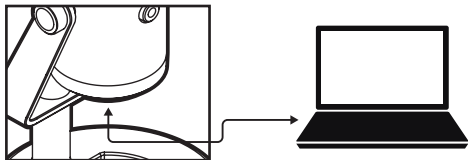




FORGE Quickstart Guide

- 1** Connect the USB-Cable to the microphone and computer.



- 2** Set computer Input and Output Sound settings to "MXL Forge"

3 Control Modes

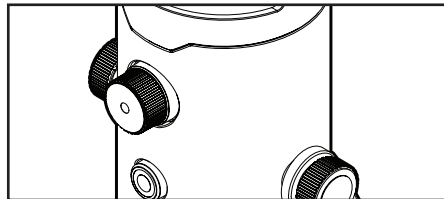
Press the control knob to toggle modes. You will see either blue or green light.

Blue Light - Adjust the level so the microphone audio is not peaking (Use the meter in your audio settings or capture software)



Green light - Adjust the headphone audio volume.

- 4** **Mute button**
Mutes the mic audio input

5 Polar Patterns - Selectable with the switch on the back of the microphone

Cardioid  – Microphone picks up audio from the front side. Best for one person using the mic for streaming and podcasting.

Omni  – Microphone picks up audio from all sides. Best for use with 2 or more people or if you're recording multiple sources at once in a room.

Note: the top of the microphone does NOT pick up any audio
